LYDDEN HILL RACE CIRCUIT, DOVER

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

For the safety of the public during event weekends at Lydden Hill Race Circuit, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on certain roads in the vicinity of Lydden Hill Circuit, Lydden, near Dover.

On those weekends when Lydden Hill is hosting events, certain roads in Denton and Wootton will be closed to through traffic, as shown below.

DENTON LANE and SHELVIN LANE closed at their junctions with A260 Canterbury Road
GEDDINGE LANE closed to the west of the entrance to AB Crush Panelcraft
SIDE HILLS (leading to CLINTS LANE) closed at the junction with A260 Canterbury Road
WOOTTON LANE closed at the junction with Stockham Lane

The above closures apply between 07:00 hours and 13:00 hours each day

~ There will be no access from the A260 Canterbury Road / The Street to Lydden Hill Race Circuit using any of the roads above ~

SHELVIN LANE closed at the junction with the A2 Trunk Road between 15:30 hours and 18:00 hours each day.

The alternative route to and from Lydden Hill Race Circuit is via A260 The Street, Canterbury Road and A2 Trunk Road, and vice versa.

Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for residents, businesses and visitors.

These restrictions apply on the following planned dates

- 27 & 28 July 2019**
- 26 August 2019**
- 26 & 27 October 2019**
- 2 November 2019**

This Order comes into force from 22 July 2019 and above restrictions may also be imposed for any other events that may subsequently be arranged during 2019.
